Special Agent Paul Russell joined the Secret Service in 2000 and spent 7 years in the Charlotte Field Office. He transferred to the Honolulu Field Office in December 2006. Special Agent Russell has been assigned to the Financial Crimes Squad, the Counterfeit Squad, and the Protective Intelligence Squad, as well as a member of the Charlotte Metropolitan Identity Theft Task Force, the Hawaii Identity Theft Task Force and the Electronic Crimes Task Force.

Special Agent Chiko Hoge has been with the US Secret Service for 5 years and was previously with Hawaii State Narcotics for 6 1/2 years. Her current responsibilities include protective assignments throughout Hawaii and South East Asia, as well as covering investigations in India and Pakistan. Special Agent Hoge holds a MBA and MSCJA from Chaminade University and a BBA from UH Manoa.
